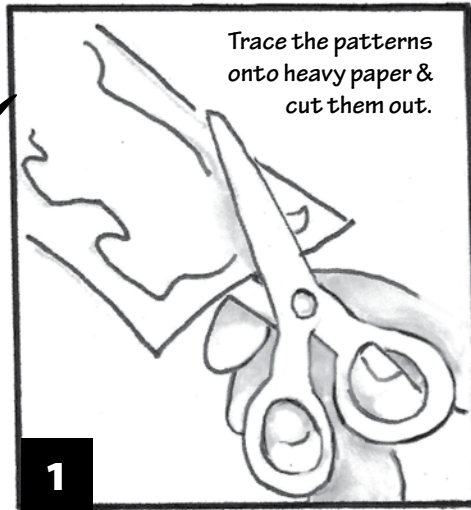


CARVING A DOG

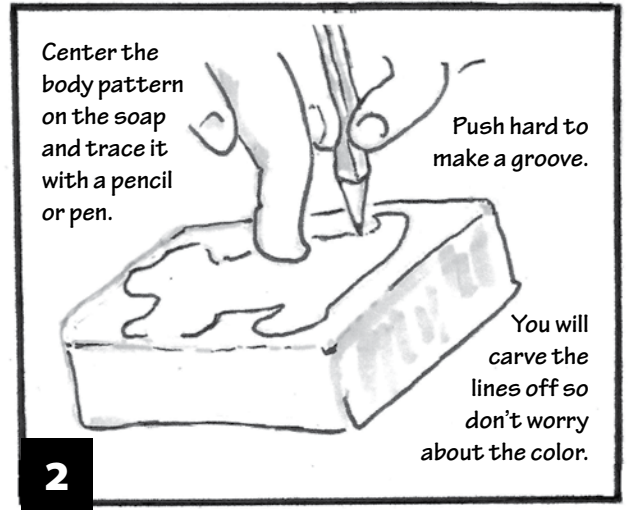

Trace the patterns onto heavy paper & cut them out.

1

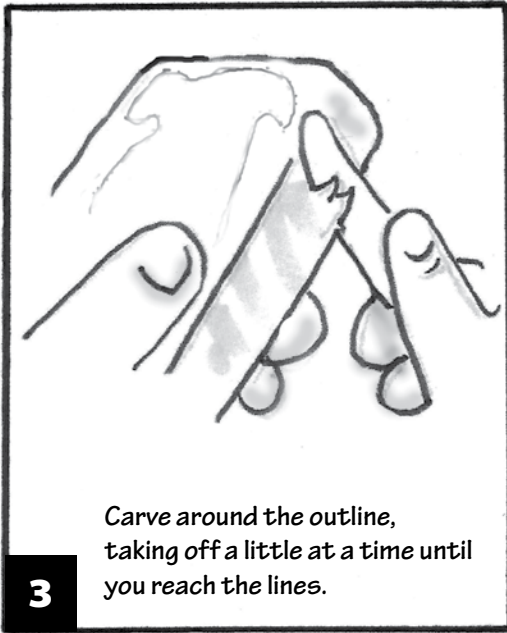


Center the body pattern on the soap and trace it with a pencil or pen.

Push hard to make a groove.

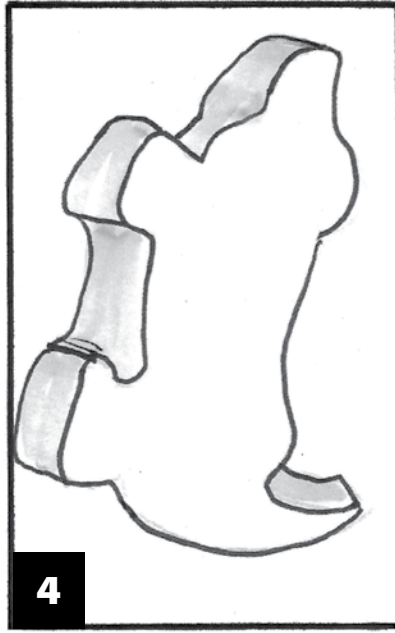
You will carve the lines off so don't worry about the color.

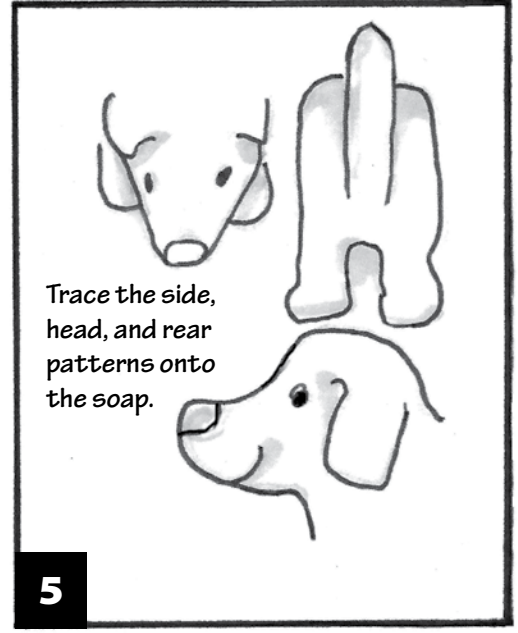


Carve around the outline, taking off a little at a time until you reach the lines.

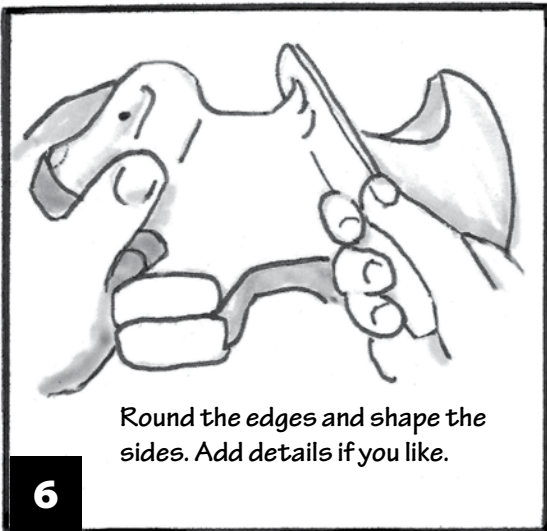

Trace the side, head, and rear patterns onto the soap.

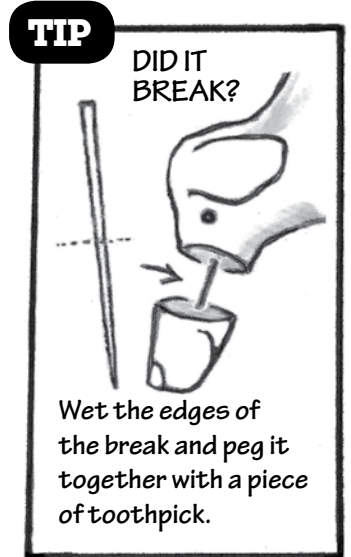
Round the edges and shape the sides. Add details if you like.

Smooth the carving with a wet sponge or your fingers (optional).

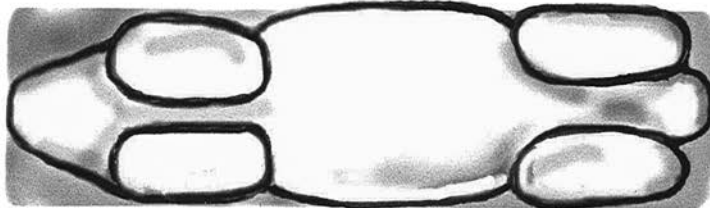
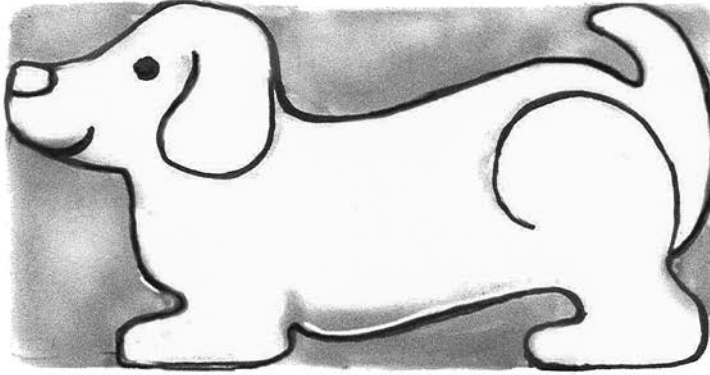
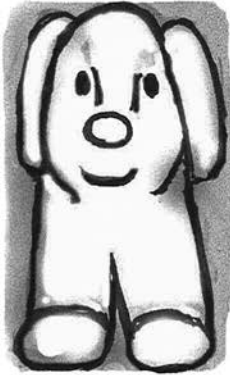
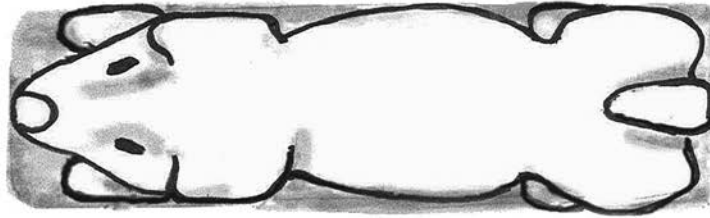
TIP
